



Studio, One, and Two Bedroom Elderly Project-Based Voucher Waiting Lists are Open for Multiple Sites until Further Notice

The Housing Authority of New Orleans (HANO) announces that waiting lists for **studio, one and two bedroom elderly** project-based voucher housing sites listed below were open on **June 16, 2017**. The period of this waiting list being open has been extended until further notice. *Please note that only pre-applications from **families who qualify for studio, one, and two bedroom elderly units** will be accepted. Furthermore, submission of a pre-application does not guarantee placement on this waiting list and placement on this waiting list does not guarantee eligibility or an offer of housing.*

Who is Eligible?

- **The family must be eligible for a studio, one, or two bedroom elderly unit based off of HANO's occupancy standards and HUD's definition of elderly. HUD defines elderly as 62 years of age or older.**
- Eligibility is based on household income, citizenship, and the ability of the family to meet screening requirements.
- HANO does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, age, familial status or disability.

How to Apply

1. **Obtain Application:** Pre-application forms are accessible on HANO's website.
2. **Complete & Submit Pre-Application:** Pre-applications must be completed and submitted online at HANO's website – <https://hano.apply4housing.com>. Assistance with completing the online application will be provided at HANO's office.

Important: If you are an individual with disabilities and need assistance with the application process please, contact HANO's Special Programs Department at (504) 670-3426 to make arrangements for the completion and submission of your application. You can also call the Special Programs Department if you have any questions regarding this application process or if you do not speak English and need translation assistance.

Placement on the Waiting List

- Pre-applications will be reviewed to ensure that the applicant family qualifies for the housing available for the particular bedroom size.
- If your completed pre-application is submitted and your family qualifies for housing in a studio, one or two bedroom elderly unit, your pre-application will be entered on the waiting list.
- Once you are placed on the waiting list, waiting time is determined by applicant order on the waiting list; the bedroom size required for the household; and eligibility for local admission preferences where applicable.
