Replace HVAC System at Florida and Fischer III Housing Communities IFB No. 24-912-29

THIS ADDENDUM IS BEING ISSUED TO INCORPORATE THE FOLLOWING IN THE REFERENCED INVITATION FOR BIDS.

Questions and Answers:

- Q: Are the units all electrical or Gas?
 - A. The units are all electrical units
- Q. Are any of these units in the attic or air handler closet in the wall?
 - A. Most of the units air handler are in the attic.
- Q. In section 2.2 reference is made to "duct work" but replacing the inside air handler may require duct work Please advise.
 - A. The duct work should be removed it was for a previous solicitation
- Q. In section 2.3 reference is made to "balconies" but replacing the ac units does not require any balcony work. Please advise.
 - A. The balcony work should be removed, it was for previous solicitation.
- Q. Page 8 references grill work but replacing thing ac units does not require replacing grills. Please advise.
 - A. The grill work should be removed as it was for a previous solicitation.
- Q. The number of unit replacements is listed as 25 in one section and 28 in another section. Please advise.
 - A. The correct scope of work was submitted in the public drive for 28 units.
- Q. Please confirm that the existing line sets should be flushed with "Diversitech Pro-Flush" per page 21, Item #4 as opposed to page 24 Part 1, 1.01 A stating that the contractor shall "Provide complete operational refrigerant piping systems ..."
 - A. If the line is not damaged and is the correct pipe size then existing line should be flushed with "Diversitech Pro-Flush".
- Q. Since brazing inside occupied units could provide a safety concern, we respectfully request the use of "zoom lock pro press fitting inside occupied units. Notwithstanding, brazing the exterior condensers does not present safety issues. I have attached the OEM's link for your review.

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A. ZoomLock MAX Refrigerant Press Fittings (parker.com) Zoom lock pro press fitting for inside can be use, please make sure the line is seal tightly so that no freon leaks.
